ADMINISTRATIVE ARRANGEMENTS.

ORDERED BY HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL.

I, JOHN LAWRENCE, BARON STONEHAVEN, the Governor-General in and over the Commonwealth of Australia, acting with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, do hereby order that the Schedule of Administrative Arrangements approved on 24th June, 1925, and promulgated in *Commonwealth of Australia Gazette*, No. 53 of 2nd July, 1925, and the amendment, approved on 13th day of August, 1925, and promulgated in *Commonwealth of Australia Gazette*, No. 64 of 20th August, 1925, be further amended as from 1st October, 1925, by the cancellation of those portions of the schedule relating to the Department of Home and Territories and the Department of Works and Railways and the insertion in lieu thereof in regard to those respective Departments of the following:—
