- 1 Name of Authorisation**
This Authorisation comprises the *Freedom of Information* (Authorised Persons – National Archives of Australia).
- 2 Commencement**
These Authorisations commence on the date they are made.
- 3 Definition**
In this Authorisation:
Act means the *Freedom of Information Act 1982* (Cth)
Archives means the National Archives of Australia.
- 4 Revocation**
All previous authorisations issued are revoked.
