SFIA

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- An open source, two dimensional skills matrix developed in 2003 (v.1) by the SFIA Foundation, a UK consortium comprising IET, IMIS e-skills UK, and BCS (V.7 currently in use)
- A capabilities framework which can be used globally
- A tool for aligning a workforce to deliver the needs of an organisation

# Professional Standards Scheme – why?

## Why new PS Scheme is a big deal:

- Professional recognition for all CP members
- A foundation for trust in ICT professionals



## Why trusted ICT professionals are needed:

- Public risk is growing (cyber security, data management, AI etc)
- Consumer protection is needed
- Society needs identifiable experts (professional & ethical)

# Professional Standards Scheme – how?

## How PS Scheme works

- Association monitors, enforces & improves member practices
- Consumer risk is reduced
- Professional Standards Councils cap civil liability
- Benefits CP members; guards against insurance crisis
