### PROCLAMATION

Commonwealth of Australia to wit. W. J. MCKELL Governor-General.

By His Excellency the Governor-General in and over the Common-wealth of Australia.

HEREAS by Proclamation dated the third day of Sep-W tember, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-nine, the Governor-General has proclaimed the existence of war:

And whereas by section 112 of the Customs Act 1901-1936 it is enacted that in time of war the Governor-General may by Proclamation prohibit the exportation of any goods:

And whereas by Proclamation No. 485 dated the thirtieth day of April, one thousand nine<sup>3</sup> hundred and forty, the exportation of certain goods therein specified was prohibited unless the consent in writing of the Minister to the exporta-tion of the goods had first been obtained:

And whereas it is desirable to amend the said Proclamation:

Now, therefore, I, William John McKell, the Governor-General aforesaid, acting with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, do hereby amend the said Proclamation by omitting from the Schedule thereto the words-

"Bags, sacks, packs, bales and mats of hessian or jute hessians and other jute piece goods, including jute canvas."

This Proclamation may be cited as Customs Proclamation No. 691.

DRAWBACK NOTICE NO. 518.

REGULATION 130 OF THE CUSTOMS REGULATIONS. (T. & C. '47/9463.)

DRAWBACK of duty may be allowed under the provisions of the Customs Remulations D of the Customs Regulations on myrtle logs used in the manufacture within the Commonwealth of veneers upon exportation of such vencers and after compliance with the said regulations.

Provided that when required by the Collector, the manufacture of the veneers shall take place under the supervision of an officer and that the Collector shall be satisfied in each case that the drawback claimed is properly due.

This notice shall have effect as on and from the 26th August, 1947.
