The enactments administered by the Minister of State administering a Department are the enactments specified in the third column of the Schedule to this Order opposite to the name of that Department and any enactment (whether passed before or after the date of this Order), not being an enactment specified at any place in that third column, that relates to a matter specified in the second column of that Schedule opposite to the name of that Department.
