ADMINISTRATIVE ARRANGEMENTS.

ORDER BY HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL.

I, RICHARD GARDINER, BARON CASEY, the Governor-General in and over the Commonwealth of Australia, acting with the advice of the Federal Executive Council—

- (a) hereby revoke so much of the Administrative Arrangements Order made on the fourth day of November, One thousand nine hundred and sixty-five, as relates to the Prime Minister's Department;
- (b) hereby approve of the Administrative Arrangements specified in the Schedule to this Order; and
- (c) order that, until further Order herein, the Acts of the Parliament of the Commonwealth specified in the third column of that Schedule opposite to the name of the Department of Education and Science shall, unless the contrary intention appears in the Act, be administered by the Minister of State for Education and Science.
