COMMONWEALTH OF AUSTRALIA
ADMINISTRATIVE ARRANGEMENTS

Order by His Excellency the Governor-General

I, SIR PAUL MEERNAA CAEDWALLA HASLUCK, the Governor-General in and over the Commonwealth of Australia, acting with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, hereby approve the following administrative arrangements:—

- (a) in addition to the Acts of the Parliament of the Commonwealth at present administered by the Minister of State for Trade and Industry, Part XII, and sections 155 to 159 (inclusive) of the Restrictive Trade Practices Act 1971 shall be administered by the Minister of State for Trade and Industry; and
- (b) in addition to the Acts of the Parliament of the Commonwealth at present administered by the Attorney-General, the Restrictive Trade Practices Act 1971, except to the extent to which that Act is administered by the Minister of State for Trade and Industry, shall be administered by the Attorney-General.
