ORDER UNDER SECTION 19B

- a reference in an Act, or in an instrument (including regulations) made or issued under an Act, to the Minister of State for Customs and Excise shall be read as a reference to the Minister of State for Police and Customs; and
- a reference in an Act, or in an instrument (including regulations) made or issued under an Act, to the Department of Customs and Excise shall be read as a reference to the Department of Police and Customs.

AUSTRALIA

ADMINISTRATIVE ARRANGEMENTS

ORDERED BY HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I, SIR JOHN ROBERT KERR, the Governor-General of Australia, acting with the advice of the Executive Council—

- (a) hereby revoke so much of the Administrative Arrangements Orders made on 8 February 1975, 28 February 1975 and 4 March 1975 as relates to the Department of Customs and Excise;
- (b) hereby approve the following administrative arrangements:
- (i) the matters dealt with by the Department of State specified in the first column of the Schedule to this Order include the matters specified in the second column of that Schedule and other matters arising under the enactments administered by the Minister of State administering that Department;
 - (ii) the enactments administered by the Minister of State administering that Department are the enactments specified in the third column of that Schedule and any other enactments, whether passed before or after the date of this Order, that relate to a matter dealt with by that Department (not being an enactment specified in the Administrative Arrangements Orders made on 8 February 1975, 28 February 1975 and 4 March 1975 or in this Order in relation to another Department);
 - (iii) the matters dealt with by the Attorney-General's Department no longer include the following matters, namely, Law enforcement and Police forces of the Northern Territory of Australia, the Australian Capital Territory and Norfolk Island; and
 - (iv) the enactments administered by the Attorney-General no longer include the *Commonwealth Police Act 1957-1973* and the matters dealt with by the Attorney-General's Department no longer include matters arising under that Act; and
- (c) hereby approve the continuation in force of the administrative arrangements set out in the Administrative Arrangements Orders made on 8 February 1975, 28 February 1975 and 4 March 1975, except in relation to the enactments and matters referred to in paragraph (b).
