ADMINISTRATIVE ARRANGEMENTS ORDER

ORDERED BY HIS EXCELLENCY THE
GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I, SIR JOHN ROBERT KERR, the Governor-General
of Australia, acting with the advice of the Executive
Council—

- (a) hereby approve the following administrative
arrangements:
 - (i) the enactments administered by the
Attorney-General no longer include the
*Australian Security Intelligence Organiza-
tion Act 1956-1973*;
 - (ii) the enactments administered by the Prime
Minister include the *Australian Security
Intelligence Organization Act 1956-1973*;
and
- (b) hereby approve the continuation in force of
the administrative arrangements set out in the
Administrative Arrangements Order made on 1
July 1975 except in relation to the enactment
referred to in paragraph (a).
