- (b) any reference in any Act, or in any instrument (including regulations) made or issued under any Act, to the Department of Services and Property shall be read as a reference to the Department of Administrative Services.

AUSTRALIA

ADMINISTRATIVE ARRANGEMENTS

ORDERED BY HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I, SIR JOHN ROBERT KERR, the Governor-General of Australia, acting with the advice of the Executive Council—

- (a) hereby revoke so much of the Administrative Arrangements Orders made on 1 July 1975 and 26 September 1975 as relates to the Department of Foreign Affairs and the Department of Services and Property;
- (b) hereby approve the following Administrative Arrangements:
- (i) the matters dealt with by a Department of State specified in the first column of the Schedule include the matters specified in the second column of the Schedule and other matters arising under the enactments administered by the Minister of State administering that Department;

- (ii) the enactments administered by the Minister of State administering that Department specified in the first column of the Schedule are the enactments specified in the third column of the Schedule and any other enactments, whether passed before or after the date of this Order, that relate to a matter dealt with by that Department (not being an enactment specified in the Administrative Arrangements Orders made on 1 July 1975 and 26 September 1975 or in this Order in relation to another Department);
- (iii) the enactments administered by the Attorney-General no longer include the *Papua New Guinea Act 1949-1974*, Part VI, and the matters dealt with by the Attorney-General's Department no longer include matters arising under that Act;
- (iv) the enactments administered by the Minister of State for Minerals and Energy no longer include the *Petroleum and Minerals Authority Act 1973* and the matters dealt with by the Department of Minerals and Energy no longer include matters arising under that Act;
- (v) the enactments administered by the Minister of State for Transport include the *Railway Agreement (Queensland) Act 1961* and the *Railway Agreement (Queensland) Act 1968* and the matters dealt with by the Department of Transport include matters arising under those Acts;
- (vi) the enactments administered by the Treasurer include the *Foreign Takeovers Act 1975* and the *Papua New Guinea Loans Guarantee Act 1975* and the matters dealt with by the Department of the Treasury include matters arising under those Acts; and
- (vii) the matters dealt with by the Department of Urban and Regional Development include the following matters, namely, Control, use and management of land and property, including office accommodation, in Australia for Australian Government purposes and Land, engineering and topographical surveys for Australian Government purposes; and

(c) hereby approve the continuation in force of the Administrative Arrangements set out in the Administrative Arrangements Orders made on 1 July 1975 and 26 September 1975 subject to the changes made by this Order.
