#### ADMINISTRATIVE ARRANGEMENTS ORDERED BY HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I, WILLIAM GEORGE HAYDEN, Governor-General of the Commonwealth of Australia, acting with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, hereby approve the following changes to the administrative arrangements set out in the Administrative Arrangements Order made on 27 June 1990, to take effect on 1 November 1991:

- (a) the enactments administered by the Ministers of State administering the Department of Industry, Technology and Commerce no longer include the Australian Trade Commission Act 1985, the Australian Trade Commission (Transitional Provisions and Consequential Amendments) Act 1985, the Export Expansion Grants Act 1978 and the Export Market Development Grants Act 1974;
- (b) the enactments administered by the Ministers of State administering the Department of Foreign Affairs and Trade include the Australian Trade Commission Act 1985, the Australian Trade Commission (Transitional Provisions and Consequential Amendments) Act 1985, the Export Expansion Grants Act 1978 and the Export Market Development Grants Act 1974; and
- (c) the enactments administered by the Ministers of State administering the Department of Industry, Technology and Commerce include the Export Finance and Insurance Corporation (Transitional Provisions and Consequential Amendments) Act 1991 and the Export Finance and Insurance Corporation Act 1991.
